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Material Exploration



Students were given translucent and transparent paper and an array of materials to create their own versions of stained glass windows or sun catchers.



They were messy, experimentative, and creative as they used materials in countless ways to later discover what would happen to the materials when light was shining on or through them.



Students used the materials in unconventional and unique ways resulting in many "woah look at what I just did" moments.



"Look we have musical instruments" they tell me as students discover that when they shake the paint markers they turn into maracas. The room becomes an energetic, imaginative art space where children feel freedom to express and explore.

Through the Windows & the Light Box



When students decided they were finished, they placed their pieces on the light box to see the effect artificial light has on the materials and the translucent and transparent paper.



The art pieces transformed into our own version of stained glass windows.



Students documented their artwork with an Ipad.
