This Saturday in the art space, students were introduced to Chandeliers and hanging installations. Over the last few weeks in SAS, the students will make different ornaments with old and new materials to hang from our special version of a Chandelier to showcase in the SAS Exhibition. Every child decorated and added their own artistic touch to a CD that reflects and shines. We attached a line of string to each CD and added various forms of beads and jewels.







As students created and explored, they were able to document their own work and others' with the iPads and cameras in the art space.
